

Cannonfields

This small estate of 1970s houses is architecturally uninspiring and is somewhat typical of the many mundane residential schemes of this period. Although the development comprises terraced housing which is a form found in the locality, the scheme lacks interesting detailing and variety and is constructed of concrete tiles and, mainly, faced fletton brickwork. It has little empathy with the character or appearance of the locality. The roadway was built to adopted highway standards and is visually intrusive.

Modern highways quality asphalt road and paving finish with rather good modern lighting standards.

The development rather detracts from the conservation area.
